

In a suitable forest

Duration: Half a day

## Forest Challenge

The event takes place in forest, such as Fontainebleau or Chantilly for example (please do not hesitate to ask us for information on the forest nearest to you.)

All teams attend an initial briefing at which equipment is allocated, training is given and route maps prepared. **Teams need to navigate their way to a number of problem solving challenge sites, to arrive by a specified time.** Bonuses can be collected on the way...however teams need to focus on priorities.

At each challenge site, teams undertake a different team challenge. Problem Solving Challenges vary in nature, being designed to draw out different qualities and skills from within the team.

Although an active event, this is not an event that requires a level of fitness beyond that of a reasonably active person. Participants should be capable of a brisk walking pace...running is not required! The emphasis is very much upon working as a team and competing against other teams from a similar background.

At the end of the event, participants receive a certificate acknowledging their achievement in completing the Forest Challenge. And of course, the winning team is awarded the trophy! Teams receive a breakdown of their performance so they can see where points were picked up (and dropped!).

**TEAM LEARNING:** encourage leadership skills, learn to work as a team, get to know one another better and improve planning and prioritizing.
